ABOUT THE ORLANDO MAGIC

Orlando's NBA franchise since 1989, the Magic's mission is to be world champions on and off the court, delivering legendary moments every step of the way. Under the DeVos family's ownership, the Magic have seen great success in a relatively short history, winning eight division championships (1995, 1996, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2019, 2024, 2025) with seven 50-plus win seasons and capturing the Eastern Conference title in 1995 and 2009. Off the court, on an annual basis, the Orlando Magic gives more than \$2 million to the local community by way of sponsorships of events, donated tickets, autographed merchandise and grants. Orlando Magic community relations programs impact an estimated 100,000 kids each year, while a Magic staff-wide initiative provides more than 7,000 volunteer hours annually. In addition, the Orlando Magic Youth Foundation (OMYF) which serves at-risk youth, has distributed more than \$30 million to local nonprofit community organizations over the last 35 years. The Magic's other entities include the team's NBA G League affiliate, the Osceola Magic, 2021 G League champions, and the Orlando Solar Bears of the ECHL, which serves as the affiliate to the NHL's Tampa Bay Lightning. The Magic play their home games at the award-winning Kia Center – voted by fans no. 1 in the NBA for game experience; honored with TheStadiumBusiness Awards' Customer Experience Award; named SportsBusiness Journal's Sports Facility of the Year; and awarded the Venue Excellence Award (VEA) by the International Association of Venue Managers. The Magic practice at the award-winning AdventHealth Training Center. The Magic was also recognized by the Sports Business Journal as one of the "Best Places to Work" in sports in 2023 and 2024. JEFF WELTMAN

President of Basketball Operations

Jeff Weltman, who brings more than 34 years of experience in basketball operations in the NBA, was named president of basketball operations of the Orlando Magic on May 23, 2017. He is responsible for overseeing all aspects of the team's basketball operations department.

Since arriving in Orlando, the Magic have advanced to the playoffs four times and captured three Southeast Division championships (2019, 2024, 2025). The Magic claimed its second consecutive division title in 2024-25, the first time Orlando has done that since 2008-09 and 2009-10. Orlando secured postseason berths in back-to-back seasons in 2018-19 and 2019-20 for the first time in eight years (since 2010-11 and 2011-12). During his second season in Orlando (2018-19), the Magic clinched a berth into the NBA Playoffs for the first time since 2012 and captured the Southeast Division title, their first since 2009-10.

Orlando selected Paolo Banchero with the first overall pick of the 2022 NBA Draft. He went on to capture the 2022-23 NBA Rookie of the Year, becoming the third player in franchise history to ever win the award. Franz Wagner, the eighth overall pick of the 2021 NBA Draft, was named to the 2021-22 NBA All-Rookie First Team, while Jalen Suggs, the fifth overall pick in 2021, was named to the 2023-24 NBA All-Defensive Second Team. The Magic improved their win total by 12 games in 2022-23, then by 13 games in 2023-24. During the summer of 2025, Orlando acquired Desmond Bane from Memphis.

Weltman came to Orlando after four seasons with the Toronto Raptors, including his final season as general manager (2016-17). He joined the Raptors as executive vice president, basketball operations in 2013.

Prior to joining Toronto, Weltman spent five seasons as assistant general manager of the Milwaukee Bucks from 2008-13. During his tenure with Milwaukee, he assisted in all basketball, salary cap and administrative matters.

Weltman came to Milwaukee following one year as director of basketball administration in Detroit (2007-08) and five seasons as assistant general manager with the Denver Nuggets (2001-06).

During his time in Denver, Weltman helped engineer personnel moves that shifted the Nuggets from a struggling team with no salary cap flexibility to one of the up-and-coming teams in the NBA. The Nuggets won 49 games in 2004-05, the fourth-most since the franchise joined the NBA in 1976. In 2003-04, the Nuggets posted the sixth-biggest turnaround in NBA history, improving their win total by 26 games and reached the playoffs for the first time since 1995.

Weltman joined the Nuggets after spending 13 seasons with the Los Angeles Clippers, where he served as director of player personnel since 1994.

The New York native originally joined the Clippers as video coordinator in 1988 and was immediately elevated to a scouting position. During his last season in Los Angeles (2000-01), the Clippers improved their win total by 16 – the biggest turnaround in the league.

Weltman graduated in 1987 from Oberlin College in Ohio, where he earned two varsity letters in basketball. He and his wife, Alexis, have twin daughters, Lucy and JJ.



ANTHONY PARKER

General Manager

Anthony Parker was named general manager of the Orlando Magic in July 2023.

During the 2024-25 campaign, Orlando went 41-41 (.500) and secured the Southeast Division title for the second consecutive time. During Parker's first season as general manager in 2023-24, Orlando posted a record of 47-35 (.573), clinched its first berth in the NBA Playoffs since 2020 and won the Southeast Division title. Orlando had 13 more wins than the previous season, which was the largest improvement in the Eastern Conference and fourth-best in the NBA.

Parker served as assistant general manager with Orlando for two seasons (2021-23). He rejoined the team after spending four seasons (2017-21) as general manager of the Lakeland (now Osceola) Magic of the NBA G League. Under his leadership, Lakeland recorded 94 regular season victories since beginning play, tied for the most in the NBA G League during that span. They capped off the 2020-21 campaign by winning the NBA G League championship.

Prior to joining Lakeland, Parker spent five seasons (2012-17) as a scout with the Orlando Magic.

Originally selected in the first round (21st overall) of the 1997 NBA Draft by New Jersey, Parker played in 494 career NBA regular season games (423 starts) during nine seasons (1997-2000, 2006-12) with Philadelphia, Orlando, Toronto and Cleveland, averaging 9.1 ppg., 3.2 rpg. and 2.3 apg. in 27.8 minpg., while shooting .404 (596-1,474) from three-point range. He also appeared and started in 22 career NBA playoff contests, averaging 10.9 ppg., 4.0 rpg., 1.4 apg. and 1.00 stlpg. in 34.9 minpg., while shooting .407 (33-81) from three-point range.

Parker also spent six seasons (2000-06) playing professionally in Europe – five seasons in Israel with Maccabi Tel Aviv and one in Italy with Lottomatica Roma. While with Maccabi, he helped them capture five Israeli Super League national championships, five Israeli National Cups and three European titles (two EuroLeague championships and one FIBA SuproLeague championship). Parker was named EuroLeague MVP in both 2003-04 and 2004-05.

Parker played at Bradley University for four seasons from 1993-97. He completed his collegiate career as one of only two players in school history (joining Hersey Hawkins) to finish in the school's top 10 all-time lists in scoring (1,683 points, eighth), assists (355, ninth), steals (159, seventh) and blocked shots (78, fifth). Parker was named Most Valuable Player of the Missouri Valley Conference following his junior season (1995-96) and was honored as one of 15 players named to Bradley's All-Century basketball team in 2003.

Parker also excelled academically while at Bradley. As a chemistry major, Parker was a two-time recipient of the Major Robert H. Lawrence Jr. Scholarship, given annually to an African-American student who does outstanding work in the field of chemistry. He switched his major during his senior year to liberal arts and science.

Parker and his wife, Tamy, have two sons, Alonso and Julian.



JAMAHL MOSLEY

Head Coach

Jamaahl Mosley became the 15th head coach in Orlando Magic history on July 11, 2021.

Mosley has compiled a career NBA regular season record of 144-184 (.439). During the 2024-25 campaign, he led the Magic to a record of 41-41 (.500), clinched their second consecutive berth in the NBA Playoffs and their second straight Southeast Division title, the first time that was accomplished since 2008-09 and 2009-10.

During the 2023-24 season, he guided the Magic to a record of 47-35 (.573), secured their first berth in the NBA Playoffs since 2020 and won the Southeast Division title. Orlando had 13 more wins than the previous season, which was the largest improvement in the Eastern Conference and fourth-best in the NBA. Mosley was named NBA Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for October/November 2023 and finished second in voting for the NBA Coach of the Year award. On Mar. 12, 2024, he agreed to a multi-year contract extension with Orlando, which runs through the 2027-28 season.

In 2022-23, Mosley led the Magic to a 34-48 record, which was a 12-game improvement from the previous season - the best improvement in the Eastern Conference and third-best in the NBA. During his first season at the helm (2021-22), Orlando finished 22-60 (.268). Mosley made his NBA head coaching debut on Oct. 20, 2021 @ San Antonio and recorded his first NBA head coaching win on Oct. 24, 2021 @ New York.

Mosley came to Orlando after spending seven seasons (2014-21) as an assistant coach with the Dallas Mavericks. While on the coaching staff, the Mavericks reached the NBA Playoffs four times. He has also served as the head coach on the Mavericks summer league team that competed in Las Vegas.

Prior to joining the Mavericks, Mosley spent four seasons (2010-14) as an assistant coach with the Cleveland Cavaliers. Before joining the Cavaliers, Mosley spent five seasons (2005-10) with the Denver Nuggets. His tenure began in player development and advance scouting, before becoming an assistant coach for his last three seasons (2007-10) with the franchise. The Nuggets reached the playoffs, winning 50 games or more, each of his final three years. They won the Northwest division twice and earned a trip to the Western Conference Finals in 2009.

Mosley was a four-year letterman at the University of Colorado (1997-2001), where he is one of 33 players in school history to score more than 1,000 points. Following his collegiate career, he played four seasons of professional basketball overseas, including two years for the Victoria Titans (Australia), one year with Baloncesto Leon (Spain) and one year in Korea.

Mosley was named head coach for the USA Basketball Men's Select Team in both 2023 and 2024, which trained with the Men's National Team prior to the 2023 FIBA World Cup and the Olympic Games Paris 2024. He also served as an assistant coach for the 2021 USA Basketball Men's Select Team and as an assistant coach at the 2018 USA Basketball Men's National Team mini-camp. Mosley has also participated in Basketball Without Borders in Africa on several occasions.

A native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, he and his wife, Kristina, have three children, Jemma, C.J. and Chance.

Ameer Bahhur will serve as head coach for the Orlando Magic during the 2025 NBA2K26 Summer League in Las Vegas. He recently completed his third season on the coaching staff with the Magic.

Prior to coming to Orlando, Bahhur spent the 2021-22 season as a part of the coaching staff with Rio Grande Valley of the NBA G League. The Vipers went on to win the 2021-22 NBA G League championship.

Bahhur began his coaching career in Las Vegas and worked as assistant director of basketball operations for UNLV for three seasons (2017-2020). He then was an assistant coach at College of Southern Nevada in 2020-21.

A native of Camarillo, CA, Bahhur graduated from Loyola Marymount University, where he also worked for the men's basketball team as a student manager.
